HIGHLIGHTS (BUT YOU SHOULD STILL WATCH THE VIDEOS!)

We should position ourselves to keep within "90 degrees" in front of us: the Runner, the Ball, the Base, the Fielder.

Plate Umpire: responsible for all tag-ups. Play at plate: position a few feet up 1st base line

Division Directors: remind your Managers: we can't start a game without a written lineup. Opposing Manager has the right to request a copy. It would help your Plate Umpire to also have a copy.

Runner-For-Batter not stopping at 1<sup>st</sup>: when Defense appeals, is a force-out because RFB must return to 1st, so "forced".

Gov Board reviewed all change inquiries. We have Rules, just enforce them. Pitcher's Screen. Courtesy Runner: once per inning, before the first pitch. Write down batting order and courtesy runners. Runner-For-Batter. Illegal contact. Outfield relay. OF > 2B >1B double play *is* legal.

## 3 Changes – Division III (02:45) <u>click here</u>

Infielder can go to grass to field ball. Non-Runner: ball to grass: live ball. Fly caught by IF on grass: awarded first, dead ball.

## 4 Other USA Rules (09:45) <u>click here</u>

Batter's Box. Speed of Pitch. Location of ball (not fielder) determines fair/foul. Line-ups and notes on Courtesy Runners. Observing pitcher.

#### 5 Plate Mechanics (11:00) *click here*

Magic's Intro: Important, not Essential. Plate Umpire responsibilities. Walk the Pitch: Stepping ONTO the rubber as he releases the pitch. Plate position in "the slot". Responsibilities. Interference/Obstruction. Into 2d Base. Play at Home: a few feet up the 1B line. Holding zone: half way to 3B in foul ground.
